

District Description

Wheeler County is home to two small communities, Bartlett and Ericson, as well as many ranches and farms. Most of Wheeler Central's students and staff call the country their home. There are three buildings that comprise the district all located in Bartlett. The system now instructs 111 students in grades K-12, 17 in pre-school and 6 in daycare. Twentythree certified staff covering levels preK-12, five FTE paras and seven additional classified staff members meet/exceed requirements set forth by the Nebraska State Department of Education. The secondary curriculum also utilizes direct instruction, online instruction, distant learning and a variety of dual credit courses through various colleges. We are also a member of the Northern Tier Consortium, a group of five schools that act as one large school system to assist in writing schools Improvement plans and utilize one standardized achievement assessment instrument (MAP) along with professional development.
